

# City of Fairfield City Council Special Meeting Tuesday, March 9, 2021 4:00 P.M. VIA TELECONFERENCE

#### Minutes

### I) Call to Order & Roll Call

Mayor Harry Price called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

## IV) Heart of Fairfield Overview and Council Goal Priority Setting

First was commercial redevelopment or rehab projects, second was residential redevelopment projects, third was Texas streetscape improvements, fourth was homeownership and neighborhood enhancement, and fifth was funding mechanisms.

Councilmember Moy stated that homeless should be a priority, and she does not want to do the housing first method for the homeless. Her priority to Heart of Fairfield is the Texas streetscape improvements, commercial spaces, and then homeownership and neighborhood enhancements.

Councilmember Tonnesen stated that Texas streetscape improvements were his priorities.

Vice-Mayor Vaccaro stated that his priorities would be commercial redevelopment or rehab projects, Texas Streetscape improvements, and then homeownership and neighborhood enhancement.

Councilmember Panduro stated that commercial redevelopment or rehab projects are her priorities.

Councilmember Bertani stated that Texas streetscape improvements are her priorities.

Mayor Price stated that commercial redevelopment or rehab projects, residential redevelopment projects, and Texas streetscape improvements were his priorities.
