Joy Pettygrove was elected to City Council for two terms 1986-1989 and 1989-1993. Unfortunately, Joy passed away in 1991 at the age of 58. Her husband, George Pettygrove, ran for Council for her vacated seat and won the election serving from 1991-1993 and a second term in 1993-1997. In 1997, he was elected Mayor and served in that role from 1997-2001.

George died in 2010 at the age of 79.

When his wife Joy Pettygrove died in 1991, he ran for her seat on the Fairfield City Council.

He was elected mayor in 1997. In November 2001, he was unseated by Karin MacMillan.

Pettygrove spent 32 years in education, prior to entering politics.

In 2003, he made an unsuccessful bid for the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District board.
