**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF
FY 2020-2021 LOW CARBON TRANSIT OPERATIONS PROGRAM GRANT ALLOCATIONS FROM
THE GREENHOUSE GAS REDUCTION FUND FOR ELECTRIC INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES AT THE
FAIRFIELD CORPORATION YARD**

WHEREAS, the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP) being one of the programs established in the Transit, Affordable Housing, and Sustainable Communities Program established by Senate Bill 862 in 2014, will draw funds from the Green House Gas Reduction Fund for operational and capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairfield is an eligible project sponsor and may receive state funding from the LCTOP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairfield was allocated a total of \$19,955 LCTOP funds for FY 2020-2021 for transit operating and capital projects and will hold these funds for up to four-years; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 862 (2014) named the State of California Department of Transportation as the administrative agency for LCTOP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairfield wishes to implement the Electric Infrastructure Upgrades project at the Fairfield Corporation Yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City of Fairfield as the fund recipient agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the applicable statutes, regulations, and guidelines for LCTOP funded transit projects.

Section 2. The City of Fairfield hereby authorizes the submittal of the following project nomination and allocation request to the Department in FY 2020-2021 LCTOP funds:

Project Name: Electric Infrastructure Upgrade

Amount of LCTOP funds requested: \$19,955

Project Description: Fund the design, engineering, and construction of electrical infrastructure upgrades at the Corporation Yard.

Contributing Sponsors: Metropolitan Transportation Commission

Section 3. The city manager or his designees are authorized to execute all required documents of the LCTOP program and any amendments thereto with the California Department of Transportation.
