ORDINANCE NO. 2021-16

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD AMENDING SECTION 12B.7 OF FAIRFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE TO CREATE THE RULES OF ONE LAKE PARK

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The definition of “One Lake Park” is hereby added to Section 12B.1 “Definitions,” of Chapter 12B, “Parks and Recreation,”:

“One Lake Park – The city park owned by the City of Fairfield and located in the Northeast Area of the city, near the intersection of Vanden Road and One Lake Drive.”

SECTION 2. 12B.7 “Swimming,” of Chapter 12B, “Parks and Recreation,” is hereby amended as follows, with additions in underline and deletions in strikethrough text:

“12B.7 Swimming.

a. No person in a park or open space area shall swim, bathe, be naked or wade in the water of any lake or stream, except with the permission of a park ranger. No person in a park or open space area shall pollute the water of any lake or stream.

b. Any Person Using One Lake Park Shall Abide by the Following:

1. Park hours are ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.
2. No swimming or diving is allowed, and no lifeguard is on duty.
3. Wading is only permitted for embarking and disembarking floating vessels at the dock and ramp facility.
4. The City is not liable for any injury to your person and minors under your supervision when you enter the lake. By entering the Lake, you assume the risks.
5. Do not leave children unattended at the dock or near the lake’s edge.
6. Do not enter the lake during medium to high winds or storms.
7. No fishing.
8. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
9. Only hand carried non-motorized vessels are permitted: standup paddleboards, canoes, kayaks, windsurfing, and sailboats.
10. All vessels must be launched and retrieved at the designated dock and ramp facility only.
11. Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) are Required to be worn by ALL Persons on the Lake At All Times (USCG-approved type I, II, III, or type V).
12. Children under 12 must be with an adult at all times.
13. All vessels must be removed from the lake by ½ hour after sunset.

14. Use of anchors is strictly prohibited.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days following its adoption by the City Council. A summary of this ordinance shall, within fifteen (15) days after passage, be published in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California with the names of the councilmembers voting for and against it.
