

ONE LAKE PARK RULES

Hours of Operation

1/2 Hour before Sunrise to 1/2 Hour after Sunset

GENERAL RULES

- **No Lifeguards are on Duty**
- **No Swimming or Diving is Allowed**
- Wading is only permitted for embarking and disembarking floating vessels at the dock and ramp facility.
- Do not leave children unattended at the dock or near the lake's edge
- Do not enter the lake during medium to high winds, or storms
- No fishing
- Pets must be on a leash at all times

FLOATING VESSELS

- **Only hand carried non-motorized vessels are permitted:**
 - Stand Up Paddleboards
 - Kayaks
 - Sailboats
 - Canoes
 - Windsurfing
- All vessels must be launched and retrieved at the designated dock and ramp facility only
- **Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs) are Required to be worn by ALL Persons on the Lake At All Times (USCG-approved Type I, II, or III, or Type V)**
- Children under 12 must be with an adult at all times
- All vessels must be removed from the Lake by 1/2 hour after sunset
- Use of anchors is strictly prohibited
