**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-215**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A DESIGN SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD AND KASL CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC. FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES TO COMPLETE THE EAST TABOR AVENUE SIDEWALK GAP CLOSURE PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City received grant funding to complete roadway and sidewalk improvements to enhance pedestrian and bicycle facilities across Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the City executed a reimbursement agreement with Union Pacific Railroad to commence their design review efforts for completion of bid documents, all of which require payment covered by the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited proposals from qualified firms and on November 30, 2020, received one proposal from KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City notified the California Department of Transportation to conduct a public interest finding to ensure compliance with California Transportation Commission Active Transportation grant funding obligations and the Local Assistance Procedures Manual; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Department of Transportation Local Assistance Engineer has notified City staff that a public interest finding was completed and that selection of KASL as the sole proposer conforms with the Caltrans LAPM.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD HEREBY RESOLVES:**

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are a substantive part of this resolution.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the city manager to execute a design services agreement between the City of Fairfield and KASL Consulting Engineers, Inc. for engineering services to complete the East Tabor Avenue Sidewalk Gap Closure Project for an amount not to exceed one hundred fifty three thousand nine hundred and forty six dollars (\$153,946).

Section 3. The public works director is hereby authorized to execute and administer amendments in an amount not-to-exceed thirty thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine dollars (\$30,789).
