RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH HNTB CORPORATION FOR THE FAIRFIELD-VACAVILLE HANNIGAN STATION PARKING LOT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Fairfield-Vacaville Hannigan Station is in a growing area of the Capitol Corridor, and the demand for parking at this station has increased quickly since opening in 2017; and

WHEREAS, a parking lot study was conducted in late 2019 found that parking demand was at 89% and would reach capacity by late 2020; and

WHEREAS, an additional parking lot is needed at the Fairfield-Vacaville Hannigan Station to provide additional parking capacity for future growth and new ridership; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a \$1.9 million Quick Strike Mobility Funding grant to fund the construction of the site improvements and parking lot expansion at the Fairfield-Vacaville Hannigan Station; and

WHEREAS, HNTB Corporation is qualified to perform the design and prepare the construction documents to construct the new parking lot; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain the services of HNTB Corporation to prepare construction ready plans and documents for the Hannigan Station Parking Lot Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The city manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Fairfield, a professional services agreement between the City of Fairfield and HNTB Corporation for the Fairfield-Vacaville Hannigan Station Parking Lot Project for an amount not-to-exceed one hundred thirty-nine thousand six hundred nineteen dollars (\$139,619).

Section 2. The public works director is hereby authorized to execute and administer amendments in an amount not-to-exceed thirteen thousand nine hundred sixty-two dollars (\$13,962).

Section 3. The city manager is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to implement the above-mentioned contract.
